After leaving the military, Tim became a full-time safety professional, eventually achieving the CSP designation. He has also received the prestigious Safety Professional of the Year (SPY) from the American Society of Safety Professionals. Tim also received the National Safety Council's 2018 Distinguished Service to Safety Award (DSSA). He is the first Safety Professional to receive both awards.*

*Tim is currently the Region II Vice President for ASSP, is on the Council of Regional Affairs as the Deputy Vice President, sits on the Society Finance Committee and is the Secretary of the Training and Communications Practice Specialty. Tim is the owner of Total Safety Compliance, Lectures for Central Washington University and is a Senior Consultant with the SafeStart team.*

*Tim has a MS in Environmental Technology from Arizona State University and is a Lecturer for Central Washington University where he is also wrapping up his second master's degree. Tim is an Ambassador for the Board of Certified Safety Professionals*

*Tim has had articles published in magazines including Safety Decisions, The Professional Safety Journal, The VPPPA's The Leader, and NSC's Safety and Health Magazine. Tim is the author of "The Core of Four", a motivational book to improve human performance.*

### **DAVID C. ROSKELLEY, MSPH, CIH, CSP, FAIHA**



*Mr. Roskelley has a Masters degree in Public Health with an emphasis in Industrial Hygiene from the University of Utah/Rocky Mountain Center for Occupational and Environmental Health (RMCOEH) and currently teaches as an adjunct faculty member. Mr. Roskelley is a Board Certified Safety Professional (CSP) as well as a Board Certified Industrial Hygienist (CIH). He is currently serving as Past Chair of the American Board of Industrial Hygiene (ABIH) and has previously served on the AIHA Board as a Director.*

*Mr. Roskelley is founding partner of R&R Environmental, Inc. a comprehensive safety, health, and environmental consulting firm based in Sandy, Utah (United States). Most recently, Mr. Roskelley was recognized for extraordinary contributions to the industrial hygiene profession and awarded the distinguished title of "Fellow" by the American Industrial Hygiene Association.*

*Mr. Roskelley is also an avid mountain climber who enjoys doing difficult things. He set a personal goal to climb the "7 summits" or the highest mountains on each of the seven continents. To date, he has climbed all seven and accomplished his goal. His next goal has been to climb the "Volcanic Seven Summits": or the highest volcano on each of the seven continents. On January 18, 2020, he reached the summit of Mount Sidley in Antarctica thus becoming the first American to complete this challenge. His next goal is to travel to the high point of the moon.*
